

What to Do with Empty Chemical Containers

Empty chemical containers may be reused or disposed of with other non-hazardous trash, provided that the following requirements are satisfied. EPA regulations stipulate that **an empty chemical container** must:

- not contain free liquid or solid residue.
- have the label removed or defaced (you can use a marker, spray paint, or cover the label entirely with a blank label).
- have the lid or cap removed.

It is not necessary to break empty glass containers when placing them in a dumpster or trash container.
